

Mr Konstantinos Apostolou was born and raised in Naoussa, Imathia. He holds a degree from the Department of Economics of the N.O.E. and a law degree from the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, and practiced law until 1988.

From 1985 to 1997, he served as General Manager of the fruit canning company "ALVENA".

He also served as Executive Advisor and Member of the Board of Directors of the packaging company AGROCAN.

From 1990 until the beginning of 1995, he was a member of the Board of Directors of the Panhellenic Union of Canners (P.E.K.).

In May 1995, with the establishment of the Hellenic Canners Association (E.K.E.), he assumed the duties of President of the Association, a position he has held continuously to this day.

Since 1999, following its establishment, he has served and continues to serve as President and Chief Executive Officer of the commercial company D.EL.KO.F. S.A., a network operating within the canning industry.
